Those teams playing on the grass courts in Townsend Street, Albury, you collect your tennis balls and scoresheets from the pavilion before the start of play. The ball fees for playing on the grass courts is \$11.50. Could the captains please collect the ball fees early in the afternoon and return the money envelope to the canteen before the end of play.

The ball fees for the hard court players have increased for the Summer pennant to help cover the cost of the tennis balls and to assist the club in maintaining the court surfaces.

All players in NASH tennis teams using new tennis balls will pay \$10 each week, whilst players using second hand tennis balls will pay \$5 each week.

The captains of each team, are reminded to collect the ball fee money and place it in the envelope provided and write your team name and date on the envelope to assist the Treasurer in collecting the ball fees.

Tennis balls can be collected from the NASH Tennis Clubrooms from 1pm each Saturday.

Each team is to return the ball fees and tennis balls from the previous weeks play before collecting the current weeks tennis balls.
