NORTH ALBURY SACRED HEART TENNIS CLUB INC IS CELEBRATING IT'S 50TH ANNIVERSARY

The North Albury Sacred Heart Tennis Club Inc., was formed, when a meeting was held at St. Anne's School North Albury on Sunday 20th March 1960 for the purpose of creating a Catholic Tennis Club in North Albury.

On the 12th September 1960 the first General Meeting was held and a committee nominated to oversee the construction of the tennis courts, club house and toilet facilities.

Over the past 50 years, there have been many tennis players use the courts for school programs, social play, junior tennis competitions, Saturday afternoon competitions, Tuesday ladies competitions as well as night pennants.

A very competitive night pennant commenced when the lights were originally constructed at the courts, called the Sutherland Trophy. This trophy was named after Kevin Sutherland.

The committee would like to speak to past and present members, who have memorabilia of the tennis club and would be interested in sharing these items with the club, for the anniversary celebrations.

The club will hold the 50th Anniversary celebrations over a weekend, in October/November 2010. Details are yet to be finalised.
